

- 3912 Unsatisfactory finale (Message “Black out writer’s full name”;
ISABEL ALLENDE in **E** shape) (78 : 95 : 467)
(i) Blue not black (23) (ii) Other colours (4 different) (15)
(iii) No blacking at all (17) (iv) Other faults (12 different) (23)
- 3913 (i) STEM / HEMMED IN BLISS for STET / NETTED IN BLISS (65 : 183 : 537)
Check once, remove knight and put it back
STE(N)T; NETTED IN BLISS = ‘clue’ to ‘captivated’
(ii) SHEEP SPIN ARMS for SHEEP UP IN ARMS (40 : 183 : 537)
‘Clue’ to ‘Rams’; four words specified
(iii) IN CUT AND HURT / SNEB / WEBBED IN BLISS for (29 : 183 : 537)
IT CUT AND HURT / STET / NETTED IN BLISS
Clue to ‘Harm’, ie, charm (= it) cut; for STET see (i)

Drupe alone developed base containers for seeds

Language used by Nova Scotia and parts of Scotland
TWI + NS; POSTAL order
(iii) Other than NIGHT MAIL (crossing) BORDER highlighted (7 different) (37 : 186 : 470)
(iv) TAINS for TWINS See (ii) (34 : 186 : 470)
- 3919 (i) No ‘elements’ entered at all; various choices in unchecked cells, (50 : 211 : 448)
eg, ARAAIC or ARMAIC for ARaMAIC
(ii) WRAC for WAAC (50 : 211 : 448)
Female combatant with a mate in Merseyside, it’s said
Homophone WACK
(iii) NORTeNA for NORTeNAs (31 : 211 : 448)
Staggeringly near tons — many North Americans fit such a description!

 symmetrical loaf shape required
 (i) TRIBUNAL (TURBINAL) included for PROMETAL (TEMPORAL) (25)

- 3943 Unsatisfactory highlighting: beginning and end of **WATLING STREET** (153 : 182 : 605)
required
(i) S of **SOUTHWARK** and Y of **CANTERBURY** (116)

- 3946 Unsatisfactory highlighting: **LEANTO, ALLIUM PORRUM** (= leek) (102 : 116 : 545)

- 3950 Unsatisfactory highlighting: **ANAGRAMS LURE OK** required (82 : 96 : 430)

(ii) S of **ANAGRAMS** not included; 8-letter word specified (15)
(iii) Others (21 different) (38)
- 3952 (i) Unsatisfactory depiction/arrangement of card-holdings (39 different) (84 : 118 : 391)
(ii) Other than **FATNESS** (longest word in E's hand) highlighted (21 different) (45 : 118 : 391)
- 3953 (i) Other than blank grid (31 : 55 : 785)
Message from clues: Erase all letters from grid
(ii) Other than **PATAPHYSICS** under the grid (10 different) (25 : 55 : 785)
- 3954 (i) **UNBARS** for **UNBAGS** (35 : 89 : 457)
Releases hound I don't lay claim to
'hound' extra word; 2 defs, one of them putative
(ii) E for I (completing jumble of **SPEM IN ALIUM**) in centre circle (25 : 89 : 457)
- 3956 Unsatisfactory anniversary (grid entry) numbering (some multiple) (86 : 117 : 464)
(i) ²**PAPER** for ¹**PAPER** (27)
(ii) No numbers at all entered (26)
(iii) ⁴**LINEN** for ¹²**LINEN** (18)
(iv) Others (16 different) (23)
Chambers Dictionary was emphasised as primary reference for anniversaries,
and the required numbers did not appear elsewhere in the grid/clues
- 3958 Unsatisfactory highlighting (**EDWARD UPWARD** in vertical 'spiral'
required) (36 : 68 : 393)
(i) Only **UPWARD** (16)
(ii) Others (15 different) (20)
- 3959 (i) **CAEIGHTEEN** for **RA(NINE →)EIGHTEEN** (83 : 141 : 710)
Hearing unexpectedly about letter to do with part of mouth
Anag **HEARING** about **TEE**
(ii) **GYRE** for **GORE** (29 : 141 : 710)
Turn on section of parachute canopy
GO, RE

- 3960 (i) MAGGIE THATCHER for CHRISTOPHER FRY in diagonal (120 : 241 : 549)
BIRTH CENTENARY in other diagonal confirmed
- (ii) CASH, or if (i) above, MASH for CAST (MAST) (93 : 241 : 549)
Nuns are quiet after Mass
Misprint, Nuts; A, ST after M
- 3961 Crotchets used for all 12 notes (4 should be minims) (52 : 140 : 560)
Clashes one letter apart → crotchets, two letters apart → minims;
the preamble effectively defined a gap, "... never more than two letters
apart alphabetically"
- 3962 Unsatisfactory highlighting/erasing (104 : 129 : 504)
HUIA was to be highlighted in the 'TODAY' half of the grid, and
erased in the 'TOMORROW' half
- (i) TODAY highlighted, TOMORROW erased; neither HUIA treated (44)
 - (ii) HUIA (in TODAY half) and TODAY highlighted;
HUIA (in TOMORROW half) untreated; TOMORROW erased (31)
 - (iii) Other variations (11 different) (29)
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
