

## Notes on Common Errors 4275 – 4326

(Error incidence : total error : total entry)

- 4276 PACO and PAVO transposed in grid halves ( 41 : 77 : 443)  
'Fore' grid used/required V, 'aft' grid C
- 4277 Wrong choice of clash(es) ( 42 : 109 : 505)  
(i) ENDURE/MESES for ENDURO/MOSES  
*Animal Farm* character(s) required, here MOSES (24)  
(ii) others (6 different) (20, including 2 in (i))
- 4279 FRIED for FRIER ( 45 : 68 : 506)  
*In pain, religious man cried out*  
i extra; homophone FRIAR
- 4280 Other than PURCHASE under grid ( 47 : 83 : 487)  
(i) FAME (29) (ii) others (7 different) (18)  
Dryden's *MacFlecknoe* includes "Thy genius calls thee not to (purchase) fame /  
In keen iambs, but mild (anagram)"; all other pairs of words were anagrammed in clues
- 4281 (i) 676 for 616 ( 19 : 133 : 675)  
Clue: NPN 6 (Neither); 67 (Prime); 676 is Square, not Neither  
(ii) 68121 (/4191) for 69169 (/4199) ( 15 : 133 : 675)  
Clue: NNPNS 6 (Neither); 68 (Neither); 681 is not Prime  
(clue for 4199 also satisfied by 4191)  
Nearly all the 76 other discrete errors caused similarly
- 4287 Other than the 'unchosen' pair of ADA(M), (ST)EVE under grid ( 72 : 104 : 407)  
(49 different)
- 4288 (i) ECHO for ECCO ( 56 : 108 : 547)  
*Beginning of eighth chapter about author over there*  
"author" extra; E(ighth) C (=chapter) C (=about) O (=over)  
(ii) other than A – B + C + D + E + F under grid (24 different) ( 38 : 108 : 547)  
The first six squares, in order, totalling 83, the number of  
Haydn's *Hen* (highlighted) symphony
- 4289 (i) TABU for TAPU (279 : 317 : 620)  
*Prohibition is what fills a bath with rum, essentially*  
TAP + (r)U(m)  
(ii) SMARMY for SMARMS ( 48 : 317 : 620)  
*Farm animals upset my special fawns*  
RAMS rev. + M' + S (=special)
- 4290 Other than (Take care of the) SOUNDS (and the) SENSE (will  
take care of itself) in perimeter ( 38 : 88 : 487)  
(i) POUNDS & PENCE (31)  
(ii) others (5 different) (7)
- 4293 POTS for PETS ( 30 : 85 : 508)  
*Raised stage for treasures*  
STEP rev.
- 4294 Incorrect towns or first/last letters thereof ( 40 : 94 : 435)  
e.g., KT for K(ingsto)N; PY for W(argrav)E (39 different)  
Towns visited, in order, in *Three Men in a Boat*

- 4298 (i) TUCOTUCO for TUCUTUCO (102 : 167 : 572)  
*Horn put up as capital on rodent*  
**S** missing from clue; CUT (=Shorn) rev. + UT + U.C. + O'
- (ii) ATOC for ATOK ( 35 : 167 : 572)  
*Furry animal known for umming and ahing primarily with lizard? No indeed!*  
**H** missing from clue (**h**umming); A(hing) + TOK(ay)
- 4301 GNAR for KNAR ( 44 : 73 : 829)  
*Sent back rotten lump of wood*  
RANK rev.
- 4304 Bar pattern/entries not as required (105 : 105 : 341)
- 4307 BATEAUS for BATEAUX ( 55 : 82 : 381)  
*Lovers embracing hate boats on river*  
H and E (non-prime positions) in HATE discarded; AT in BEAUX  
Chambers allows BEAUS and BEAUX, but not BATEAUS as plural
- 4308 136/676 for 134/674 ( 32 : 84 : 499)  
Both pairs of answers satisfied clues, but 136 appeared correctly elsewhere; "No two grid entries are the same".
- 4310 Net depiction (of The L-Shaped Room) not as required ( 85 : 95 : 377)  
(i) Dividers between faces not shown (52)  
(ii) others (28 different) (33)  
Preamble: "... outline the eight faces involved".
- 4311 Deficiency in entries starting/ending on French coast/border ( 46 : 66 : 391)  
e.g. .OTEEN for POTEEN, LANA. for LANAI, NIC. for NICE etc.  
(14 different)
- 4312 Various faulty depictions of valence electron rings of CARBON ( 81 : 91 : 325)  
(not BORON) (to be highlighted) and associated choice of alternatives  
in atomic no. 6 (not 5)
- 4314 (i) Perimeter (8 × ID EST) not highlighted in PINK (I.E. [Brown]) ( 31 : 79 : 350)  
(6 different)
- (ii) SARCES for SORCES (SOUCE) ( 30 : 79 : 350)  
*Wall with beheaded pikes for Thelma's pickles?*  
Wall misp. Well, Thelma → Hamlet; SO + (l)UCES (Shak. spelling)
- 4315 Faulty highlighting of one or more letters of COLDITZ ( 58 : 107 : 443)  
(i) First O (unchecked) of GOOD O(H) (36)  
(ii) others (14 different) (7)  
Clueing specified C of CODDLE/ENDOCRINAL, O (second in GOOD O(H)/first in OFFROAD), L of GLEDE, D of DRUPEL, I of À POINT, T of OCTA/STOW, Z of ZEALOT
- 4316 ENCASE for INCASE (113 : 133 : 411)  
*Line to make safe*  
2 meanings (one 'IN CASE')
- 4317 DINOSAURSPECK for DINOSAURYPECK ( 66 : 97 : 441)  
I.e., DINO (clued) + SAURY + PECK (clued) → DINOSAUR + RYPECK  
Connecting word was required; SAUR(S) not so

- 4318 Wrong choice of alternative answer(s), so not spelling ALTERNATIVES ( 31 : 68 : 432)  
(i) AREOLA for AREOLE (12)  
(ii) others (19)
- 4320 AIDE for AINÉ ( 68 : 134 : 575)  
*French senior administrator's top during école's term*  
A(dministrator) + IN + (écol)E
