| 2477 | NEN / ENTS for MEN / EMTS <i>First chap to catch a fish</i> (MAIDEN) IDE in MAN; less jumbled IDA = MEN <i>Poultices may decompose – sell on time</i> (EMOLLIENTS) Anag. SELL ON TIME; less jumbled LIONEL = EMTS | (56 : 82 : 175) |
| 2478 | EASE for EASY <i>Army standing order – slept-in uniforms are no credit</i> CREASY less CR | (78 : 98 : 175) |
| 2485 | SCOT for SCAT <i>Tax, a silver coin</i> SC[E]AT | (128 : 145 : 312) |
| 2486 | RANDLETREE for RANTLETREE <i>Frolic for Mac, permitted by bird, a tall rawboned lady</i> RANT + LET + REE | (21 : 32 : 309) |
| 2488 | POSE / PIPE for POSY / PIPY <i>Motto on a ring would make popsy pout!</i> PO(P)SY <i>High pitched and tubular</i> 2 meanings | (16 : 23 : 164) |

| | (ii) TINT / SPINT for (S)TENT / (RE)PENT <i>Be niggardly with an allowance</i> 2 meanings <i>One may have a change of heart about house</i> (RE) + PENT | (21 : 59 : 175) |
| | (iii) DADA / TRAPE for DAD(O) / (T)ROPE <i>The art form to cut a dash</i> DADA - A <i>A climbing party has to pull a horse twenty feet</i> 3 meanings | (13 : 59 : 175) |

| 2512 | NOSED / MISSLE for NOTED / MISTLE <i>Having crew cut, Editor was well known</i> NOT + ED. <i>Confuse with fine rain</i> 2 meanings | (13 : 20 : 232) |

| 2515 | VENAE / LEI for PENAL / ELI (PLANE / LIE) <i>Smooth, level surface, often spotted</i> 3 meanings | (21 : 33 : 303) |
| 2516 | MALISON for SALAMON <i>Ancient form of Mass that has a reactionary name, unfortunately</i> NOM + ALAS rev. | (15 : 38 : 258) |
