

## Notes on Common Errors 2615 – 2666

(Error incidence : total error : total entry)

- 2615 SALSE for SASSE ( 15 : 31: 223)  
*Top dressing addition for American food*  
SASS, ANNEXE (i.e. annex E) ? SASSE
- 2616 (i) VESTRIS for VENTRIS ( 14 : 42: 288)  
Name of person who deciphered ‘Linear’ scripts
- (ii) Wrong method of entry ( 7 : 42: 288)  
Entries were to be jumbled; *Linear C* is a jumble of *en clair*
- 2617 Bars and/or numbers missing or misplaced ( 68 : 75: 335)
- 2619 ENISLE for INISLE ( 16 : 36: 402)  
*Head of iniquitous brownie the French cut off*  
I + NIS + LE
- 2627 (i) UNIT for UNIO ( 10 : 45: 315)  
*17 down [PEARL] may be (operating) mine – 20% of NUM laid off*  
UNIO(N)
- (ii) ALME for ALMA ( 9 : 45: 315)  
*Dancer’s (crazy) German dance not in fashion*  
ALMA(IN)
- 2628 (i) LATIN for LADIN ( 68 : 100: 357)  
*Romance language gets a dashing fellow alight*  
LAD + IN
- (ii) SALT for SAUT ( 40 : 100: 357)  
*Scottish wit? We’ll have to make it do*  
S.A. + UT
- 2633 FIBER for LIBER ( 28 : 46: 184)  
*Bast matting’s first put in being flexible*  
LI(M)BER
- 2635 EMEU for EHEU ( 49 : 74: 404)  
*Alas! Man gets stuck into disembowelled bird*  
HE in E(M)U

- 2636 (i) Encoding error(s) ( 19 : 40: 323)  
(ii) DEMONISE for DEMONIST ( 9 : 40: 323)  
*I'm under the influence of spirits or – put crudely – I'm stoned*  
Anag. I'M STONED
- 2637 (i) LACOSE for LAC(T)ASE ( 59 : 93: 295)  
*By the sound of it didn't have outstanding enzyme*  
i.e. LACKED ACE, homophones  
(ii) MURICAE for ME(T)RICA(T)E ( 17 : 93: 295)  
*Jim finally to get out of no 10? Get the point?*  
M + E(X)TRICATE
- 2641 THERIACS for THERIACA ( 62 : 77: 388)  
*Antidotes in sheath getting return of breath, once stifled*  
AIR rev. in THECA
- 2645 REBEL / BEND or REPEL / PEND for REFEL / FEND ( 18 : 31: 266)  
*Refute wind's dance, take action to improve piano tone*  
REEL / REFEL / REFELT  
*Word spirit is the very devil to destroy*  
FIEND / FEND / END
- 2649 (i) PENMANTS for PENMONED (PENNONED) ( 14 : 39: 135)  
*Waiter has poet confused with streamers*  
Misprint 'writer'; PEN + anag. DONNE  
(ii) LAOD for LAOK (LARK) ( 9 : 39: 135)  
*Prank's a sightless song or a poet*  
Misprint 'of'; 'The lark becomes a sightless song' (Tennyson)  
(iii) ABORISIN for ABORISEN (ABORIGEN) ( 6 : 39: 135)  
*Indigenous type in cutback borage in confusion*  
Misprint 'outback'; anag. BORAGE IN
- 2650 THE MUSICAL BOY / BODY for Playfair code phrase:  
THE MUSICAL BOX (or wrong coding) ( 56 : 66: 221)
- 2652 (i) Numbers not done / incomplete ( 32 : 58: 101)  
(ii) Reversal not done / incomplete ( 21 : 58: 101)  
(iii) Bars not done / incomplete ( 14 : 58: 101)  
(iv) PIECES for PRECIS ( 6 : 58: 101)  
*Abstract money from those that are high and vertical*  
PRECI(PICE)S

- 2654 One or more wrong names ( 42 : 49: 115)  
(Characters from Evelyn Waugh's novels)
- 2655 (i) ANTONIO or ANTONIN for ANTONIA ( 52 : 89: 151)  
St. Antonia's emblem is 'barrel' (answer to clue)
- (ii) Wrong name at the bottom ( 37 : 89: 151)  
Saint Swithin, the theme being SAINTS WITHIN
- 2656 (i) CREPY for CRAPY ( 11 : 53: 368)  
*About to pray after disaster – like some material for mourning?*  
C + anag. PRAY
- (ii) DERV for DEEV ( 9 : 53: 368)  
*Scots perish contending with evil spirit*  
DEE + V(ersus)
- 2658 Central (2 ? 2) squares wrong ( 27 : 29: 94)  
Diagonals (bishop's moves) contained provinces of Bishops,  
thereby fixing these squares.  
(ELIEN, EBOR, CESTR, EXON, WINTON)
- 2659 Entries contrary to instructions ( 18 : 42: 189)  
Down answers were to be jumbled on entry
- 2660 TENS, TONS or TUNS for TINS ( 32 : 38: 294)  
*More than one can fool about on Sunday*  
NIT rev. + S
- 2661 Failure to enter according to theme ( 13 : 27: 219)  
The title read 'NO R M (in) A(cross) and R O (in) D(own)'
