(Error incidence : total error : total entry)

- 2816 BEGAT / AT (reversed and anticlockwise in quotation) (15 : 29 : 323)
for BEGOT / TO
Made son take part of the Bible for granted
BEG + O.T.
- 2817 Bars incorrect (12 : 16 : 171)
- 2818 SELA for SELF (14 : 44 : 176)
Hebrews pause in psalm, perhaps without surprise, as fourth note follows the same old style
SEL(AH) + F
- 2819 (i) ST-DRAM-EON for ST-DRAM-ION [ST-ELL-ION] (29 : 63 : 158)
Lizard darts about with me drunk
Anag. DARTS + MI +ON
- (ii) TA-(REL or REM or REP or NEL)-D for TA-BEL-D [TA-BAR-D] (21 : 63 : 158)
Sailor long ago explained without an overcoat
AB in TELD
- (iii) CROPER for CR(U)PPER (20 : 63 : 158)
Pig right to replace old strap
R for O in COPPER
- 2821 Incorrect entry of bars and/or shading (45 : 47 : 190)
- 2822 (i) AROW for AREW (103 : 114 : 237)
Lined up a victim of Hyde's to be beheaded
(C)AREW
- (ii) MARGHERITA or MARGHERITE for MARGUERITE (9 : 114 : 237)
Marguerite (Lambert) in *The Winding Stair* by A.E.W. Mason
- 2823 (i) ADA or $\frac{1}{A}$ DA for IDA (37 : 55 : 248)
Would he take a daily peep at the girl on page 3?
DLM; A DA is not a mixture
- (ii) Title wrong or missing (19 : 55 : 248)
- 2829 TATER for TATEK (TOPEK) (38 : 59 : 342)
Drink king tasted – a cool tent?
TOPE + K; tasted = ATE (new 'heart')
- 2830 EATINGS for INGESTA (12 : 23 : 151)
Seating's laid out for meal perhaps
Anag. SEATING

- 2834 ENCAGE for INCAGE (16 : 32 : 245)
Imprison the nice gaffer who said it
DLM
- 2835 (i) Entries not “mirrored” at all (49 : 89 : 158)
(ii) AGOE for YGOE (12 : 89 : 158)
The former energy contained since then
GO in YE
(iii) HOBO for HOMO (11 : 89 : 158)
Hold onto low man
HO + MO(O) (O is extra letter)
(iv) Odd letter(s) not “mirrored” (10 : 89 : 158)
- 2836 (i) THEA for RHEA (104 : 181 : 404)
Goddess, burying head, becomes another
If RHEA “buried head”, HERA would ensue
(ii) N for NE at LINER/BONE intersection (63 : 181 : 404)
NE, NW, SE, SW were not to be separated into two entries
(iii) ENWREATHING for INWREATHING (17 : 181 : 404)
Encircling desperately twining hare
Anag. TWINING HARE
(iv) GEE for GOE (15 : 181 : 404)
Canoe gets lost, up the creek
DLM
- 2838 Quotation misspelled (20 : 37 : 116)
- 2839 Greek letters entered incorrectly (116 : 134 : 209)
(a) not at all
(b) not all required letters
(c) too many Greek letters entered
(d) partly or totally lower case Greek
- 2840 VIRL for VRIL (11 : 37 : 326)
Fluid, obtained from chopped liver, which takes away energy
Anag. LIVER less E
- 2841 Various entries in unchecked squares in triangular numbers (77 : 78 : 145)
- 2842 Missing and/or extra bars (36 : 44 : 251)

- 2844 (i) IMPORTUENESS for IMPORTTENESS (13 : 41 : 291)
 (omitting NAT instead of UNA in IMPORTUNATENESS)
Pressing urgency: I left a number in confusion
 I, + PORT, TEN in MESS
- (ii) NTHEN for NTEEN (SEVENTEEN less SEVE) (13 : 41 : 291)
It made one grieve some time ago, after close of Edwardian age
 TEEN after N
- 2845 Title missing or wrong (25 : 39 : 231)
- 2846 (i) ATTU or ATFU or ATOU for ATIU (10 : 26 : 100)
Island, South Pacific group, systematically located
 4th letters
- (ii) LAPWING for WAXWING (10 : 26 : 100)
Bird with Irish name caught by beak
 WAX + N in WIG
- 2848 Failure to understand theme (18 : 18 : 84)
 Seven place names to be split in two: all in CORN WALL (to be deduced)
- 2849 (i) Wrong sign or entry for LEO / LION (33 : 48 : 115)
- (ii) Hercules wrongly or not indicated (26 : 48 : 115)
- 2852 TROAT for TROUT (27 : 39 : 231)
Does it make strong song?
 STRONG with **TR OUT** is SONG
- 2855 (i) SORDANCES for SORDDNCES (18 : 44 : 128)
 SWORD-DANCES with two letters removed; instructions were that in cases of ambiguity in unchecked letter (underlined) *first* letter was to be used
- (ii) SPEARASS / AALSE for SPERRASS / RALSE (10 : 44 : 128)
 SPEAR-GRASS and REALISE with two letters removed
Get it clear
 REALISE (2 meanings)
- 2856 Letters in pockets not “reading right to left” as required (36 : 52 : 191)
- 2858 (i) UNIT or UNIO for UNI– (53 : 74 : 141)
It indicates either of its two parts but only when joined up
 UN + I; all punctuation marks or spaces in multi-word answers occupied their own squares
- (ii) Hyphens or apostrophes or blobs etc. for blanks (19 : 74 : 141)

- 2860 MCE / MEC / MCE for MCC in special entries (44 : 61 : 281)
 E to be replaced by MCC (MC²) in EINSTEIN and RELATIVITY
- 2861 (i) SMITH for SMITE (19 : 42 : 279)
Beat fashion? Hard going for last of lounge lizards
 SMITH with E for H ('lizards' redundant)
- (ii) POLACRE for CONACRE (10 : 42 : 279)
What Irish landlords may do: pore over large measure
 CON + ACRE
- 2864 TOURED for SOURED (POURED also accepted) (13 : 33 : 156)
Once again fit, turned up in crude ruck
 CURED (anag. CRUDE) (with two new 'heads': S, O) = TURNED
- 2866 Unchecked and/or intra-checked letters misplaced in 'Composers' (17 : 20 : 94)
 Order of unchecked letters hinted at by "been excess" = B N X C S
